Minutes of ACTC 21 May, 2019: Athletics Federation of India

The ACTC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri R.S. Julaniya, Secretary (Sports) to consider ACTC calendar and budget request for Athletics Federation of India (AFI). List of members present in the meeting is at *Annexure-I*.

- 2. At the outset Secretary (Sports) stated that in view of the Olympic Games, 2020 the ACTC calendar and budget would be approved up to September, 2020. The budget ceiling would be 150% of the expenditure incurred last year. In the event additional funds become available ACTC meeting could be scheduled in future to approve additionality to the sanctioned budget.
- 3. President, AFI made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:-
- 3.1 AFI would ensure holding of State level competitions as per the calendar. Secretary (Sports) stated that modifications, if any, in the State calendar would be considered upto 15 June, 2019. Thereafter, no modification would be entertained.
- 3.2 AFI would make its best efforts to achieve the following targets:
 - (a) Olympic Games, 2020 2 3 Medals
 - (b) IAAF World Chamionship, 2021 2-3 Medals
 - (c) Asian Games, 2022 25 Medals
 - (d) CWG, 2022 8 Medals
 - (e) Olympic Games, 2024 5 Medals
- 3.3. AFI would ensure scientific testing of all players participating in national camps and international training /events atleast once in a year. Parameters for scientific testing would be worked out by AFI within four weeks. Secretary (Sports) assured that SAI would make requisite arrangements at SAI Centres at the earliest for testing facilities.
- 3.4. Data would be captured by developing suitable online application in consultation with SAI protecting right to privacy of the player. SAI and AFI would jointly work to put in place a robust system by 15th July, 2019. DDG, SAI assured team work for this.
- 3.5. Junior players winning medals in senior category would be nominated for participation in camps and international events only in senior category.
- 3.6. AFI would make its best efforts for early talent scouting. Various sporting events such as Inter-district, State and National Level Competitions would be for a for identification of talent. AFI would submit a self-contained proposal for financial assistance in this regard to DDG, SAI which would be funded under Khelo India.
- 3.7. AFI would enforce discipline with zero tolerance to indiscipline. In this regard following decisions were taken:

- (i) AFI would adopt a system of registration to register athletes participating in national level competitions and camps. These athletes would be issued photo identity cards displaying their date of birth. Such registration would be valid for five years.
- (ii) No unauthorized absence from national camps would be allowed. No one would be allowed entry after start of the camp. Based on the recommendations of an officer authorized by AFI leave of absence would be allowed only by prior permission of the Head of Institute where coaching camp is organized. Unauthorized absence during dope testing call would be presumed as deliberate leading to consequent action by AFI.
- (iii) AFI would prescribe a proforma for declaration, which would inter-alia include the following:-
 - (a) Age
 - (b) Camp norms
 - (c) Follow No Needle Policy
 - (d) Allow random checking of rooms/personal belongings.
 - (e) No unauthorized absence.
 - (f) Scientific testing and use of data by Govt for analysis and research.
 - (g) Follow the training schedule.
 - (h) Follow the Rules and Regulations.
 - (i) Punctuality.
- (iv) If the above declaration is found false, particularly with regard to using of banned substance or cheating on age, AFI would suspend player's registration up to three years.
- (v) To avoid cheating only full name of players would be mentioned. Abbreviation in the name would not be allowed. In case of similar names, name of father/mother would be compulsorily mentioned.
- 4. The calendar and budget was considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The approved calendar and budget is at Annexure II. Keeping in view the Olympic Games, 2020 the following one time relaxations, which would not be taken as a precedent, were allowed:
- 4.1 Relaxation in upper ceiling of camp days.
- 4.2 Relaxation in juniors-senior player ratio for National Camps.
- 4.3 Relaxation in upper ceiling of days for competition / training abroad.
- 5. Other salient decisions are as below:
- 5.1 Machines and equipments for javelin to be procured under ACTC in a time bound manner so as to ensure timely availability. AFI would procure in a competitive and transparent manner. SAI would nominate a member in the procurement committee of AFI.
- 5.2 For procurement of above machines and equipments grant to be released in two instalments to AFI 50% of the amount approved in the budget as advance and remaining 50% on procurement. AFI would maintain inventory and records of consumption. Any machine/equipment having life of more than 2 years would be housed in and handed over to NSNIS, Patiala.

- 5.3 To sanction Synthetic Track at SAI HATC, Shillaroo and relaying of Synthetic Track at SAI LNCPE, Trivandrum under infrastructure head of Khelo India. Director (Infra), SAI promised that these facilities will be ready and available by 1st November, 2019.
- 5.4 Wherever duration of camp during summer season is more than 90 days and during non summer season more than 45 days subject wise tuition for English, Science and Mathematics each subject would be arranged by AFI or SAI. Upper ceiling for remuneration to a tutor would be Rs.15,000/- month and expenditure would be incurred under national camps.
- 5.5 For high altitude training, Department of Sports would do facilitation for making the facilities at Ooty (Tamil Nadu) available to NSF.
- 5.6 In the event players, who are otherwise not eligible for air travel, undertake domestic air travel for camps/international events, reimbursement of fare would be made subject to a ceiling of applicable AC-II tier rail fare + 25%.
- 5.7 SAI infrastructure and sports facilities, if available, would be provided for State and National level competitions at nominal cost.
- 5.8 Department of Sports would grant necessary sanction for coach development under HRDS. AFI would submit a self-contained proposal to Director (Sports) in this regard. 75% of the cost for upgrading knowledge/skills and acquiring higher level accreditation from International Federation would be funded under the HRDS with the condition that the beneficiary pays 25%. In case of SAI coaches remaining 25% cost would be reimbursed to those who succeed in acquiring higher level accreditation alongwith their TA/DA. SAI would ensure participation of all SAI coaches in the programme.
- 5.9 A sum of Rs. 50.00 lakh is approved as contingency expenditure to meet unforeseen expenditure relating to facilities to athletes, coaches and support staff at the discretion of AFI.
- 5.10 Coaching camp would not be shifted from the places approved in the calendar. In the event of shifting of camp place additional financial burden, if any, would be borne by AFI.
- 5.11 NADA would arrange for testing of players at national camps and national competitions and gradually expand its capacity to cover state level annual competitions in due course.
- 5.12 National coaches and support personnel required for more than 200 days in a year to be hired on yearly basis and paid monthly remuneration instead of hiring them on daily basis.
- 6. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
