Subject :- 18th National Federation Cup Junior (U-20) Athletics Championships

Dear Sir,

I am pleased to inform you that 18th National Federation Cup Junior (U-20) Athletics Championships 2021 will be organized by Department of Sports & Youth Welfare, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh at T.T. Nagar Stadium, Bhopal from 25-27 January 2021.

Reckoning of Age/Eligibility

Athletes should be below 20 years as on 27th January 2021. Athletes below 16 years on 27th January 2021 are not eligible to participate in this championships. In other words, an athlete should have born between 25th January 2005 and 27th January 2001.

Age Verification

AFI Age Verification Committee and a team of doctors will be present to assess the age of athletes.

Proof of Age

The athletes are required to bring with them the following original certificates for verification:-

- (i) X Standard Certificate or equivalent from recognized Central/State Board indicating Date of Birth
- (ii) Birth Certificate from Municipality/Corporation and School Leaving Certificate, if an athlete has not passed X Standard and is a drop out.
- (iii) Birth Certificate from Municipality/Corporation in case of athletes, who have not gone to School at all.

Last Date of Entry

Online Entry of athletes will start on 11th January 2021. The last date for receipt of entries is 20th January 2021. Entries received after due date will not be accepted.

Entries

It is mandatory to fill all columns in "On-Line" Entry Form.

Procedure for Sending Entries

Please note that Entry of Athletes is to be sent "Online" by the respective Secretary of the State Athletics Association and **NOT** by the individual athletes.

Entry Fee

Entry fee of INR 50/- per Event to be paid online along with Entry.

Number of Entries

Each State Unit can send three athletes in each event. No reserve entry is permissible.

Number of events an athlete can participate

An athlete can participate in two individual events.

Flags

Each participating units is required to send its Flag with the Manager of the Team.

Dope Test

Dope Tests will be conducted by NADA during the Championships

Banned Athletes

All the State/UT Secretaries should ensure that they do not include names of athletes, who have been banned by AFI for participation in Junior Meets, due to Overage or Dope.

Participation Certificates

It is the duty of the Managers/Coaches to collect the Participation certificates from AFI Officials at the Venue of Championships. Participation Certificates will be issued to only those athletes, who qualify the Entry Standard already circulated.

Boarding & Lodging

It may also be noted that Boarding and Lodging facilities to Athletes/Managers/Coaches will not be provided by the Organizers due to COVID – 19 pandemic. The participating states will therefore have to make their own arrangements in this regard.

It may please be noted that Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) prepared by AFI and other guidelines issued by the concerned State Government in connection with COVID-19 pandemic are strictly followed to ensure that the competition is conducted smoothly.

Separate SOP in this regard will also be issued by the Organising State Association and participating State Units should adhere the same for the safety of Athletes/Officials. Any Athlete/Official found violating the SOP/Guidelines issued in regard to Covid – 19 will be debarred from participation in this Championships.

Your kind cooperation for the successful conduct of the Championships is solicited.
