Subject: - Regarding District Technical Officials Seminar cum Examination for Affiliated North-East States

Athletics Federation of India is conducting District Technical Officials Seminar cum Examination from 16th to 18th November 2021 in Kohima, Nagaland. The objective of this examination is to educate and create awareness on the Competition and Technical Rules among all the stakeholders who are interested in Athletics officiating at the grass root level which will be support District Athletics Associations in conducting their Championships. The details of registration is given below:

1. Start Date of Registration – November 1st, 2021 (Midnight)

3. Minimum Qualification - Matriculation

4. Registration Fee - INR 2000/-

5. Date of Course - 16-18 Nov. 2021(Class timings will be informed later)

6. Venue - Kohima, Nagaland

7. Date of Examination - 19 Nov. 2021

8. Registration Link - Available on AFI Website <u>www.indianathletics.in</u>

Examination Format -

The candidates who get 60% score will be declared 'Pass' and all the District Athletics Associations must ensure that only such qualified persons are appointed as Technical Officials for their District Athletics Championships in future. Only candidates who have passed the DTO examination will be eligible to apply for next level- Federation State Technical Officials [FSTO] examination and shall be considered for appointment in the State as well as National Championships as Technical Officials.

There will be classes on officiating various Athletics Events for two and a half hours and classes will be conducted by eminent and well experienced lecturers and technical officials and who have officiated in a number of National and International Competitions including Commonwealth Games and Asian Championships. The classes will be conducted in English language.

All the State Athletics Association Secretaries from North-East States should consider this matter very seriously. You must ensure the participation from every district in your state since there is lot of rooms for improvement in standard of technical conduct of Athletics Competitions at the grass root level. You may convene a meeting of the secretaries of your district units to elaborate this and give maximum publicity through press and social media and ensure that this information is reached every interested person in due time.

Admission, Facilities & Other Arrangements-

- 1. Only Online Registrations will be accepted after payment of fee of INR 2000/-
- 2. All the classes will be held offline and in-person at Kohima, Nagaland.
- 3. Participants from host state of Nagaland <u>ONLY</u> are eligible for Travel, Boarding and Lodging arrangements which will be provided by the Nagaland Athletics Association.
- 4. Participants from other near-by states may avail Accommodation and Food facilities on payment basis from Nagaland Athletics Association. For request/enquiries on Accommodation at Kohima, participants shall contact-
