Subject: - Regarding Online Federation State Technical Officials Seminar cum Examination (FSTO)

Indian Athletics – Athletics Federation of India is conducting Online Federation State Technical Officials Seminar cum Examination (FSTO) from 22nd to 28th February 2022.

Eligibility:

The eligibility to apply for the FSTO examination is-

- 1- You have successfully completed and passed DTO examination one year before i.e. in January 2021
- 2- Those who have qualified FSTO examination conducted by AFI before January 2018 and did not qualify as FTO. Such FSTOs has to appear for this examination to continue as FSTO as per rules mentioned in AFI Manual according to which Technical Official qualification has a validity of four years only.

Details for Registration and Examination

1. **Start Date of Registration** - January 27, 2022 (Midnight)
2. **End Date of Registration** - February 20, 2022 (Midnight)
3. **Registration Fee** - INR 3000/- (Plus Bank Charges)
4. **Date of Course** - 22-28 February 2022 (17:00 hrs. onwards on Zoom)
5. **Date of Theory Examination** - 03rd March 2022 (10:00 hrs. to 11:00 hrs.)
6. **Date of Viva Examination** - Will be informed Later

7. Registration Link - Available on AFI Website (www.indianathletics.in)
8. Zoom classroom link will be provided on the day of lecture to the registered candidates on the registered email id/Whatsapp.


Examination Format -

The candidates who score 75% marks will be declared 'Pass'. Those candidates who have passed the FSTO examination alone will be eligible to apply for next level 'Federation Technical Officials [FTO]' examination.

Online Classes -

There will be classes on officiating various Athletics Events for two hours on all Seven days. It will be handled by eminent and well experienced lecturers and technical officials who have officiated on a number of National and International Competitions including Commonwealth Games and Asian Championships. The classes and Examination will be conducted in English language only.
